A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENSON, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO APPLY FOR A TOHONO O'ODHAM GRANT TO PURCHASE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, each year the Tohono O'odham Nation awards grants to Arizona cities, counties and towns for public health and safety purposes from gaming revenue; and


WHEREAS, the City of Benson desires to submit a grant proposal in the amount of \$3,200 to purchase a hand-held radar, two portable breath testing devices and two tint meters; and

WHEREAS, this year's deadline is June 18, 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Benson, Arizona that the Chief of Police is authorized to submit a grant proposal to the Tohono O'odham Nation in the amount of \$3,200 for the above equipment;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the City is awarded said grant, the Chief of Police is hereby authorized to purchase said items from the grant funds in accordance with the City's procurement code.
