

RESOLUTION 3-2010

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENSON, ARIZONA, SUPPORTING THE CITY'S APPLICATION FOR A RURAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND PLANNING ASSISTANCE GRANT TO FUND AN OUTSIDE CONSULTANT TO ASSIST IN A COMPREHENSIVE UPDATE OF THE CITY'S ZONING REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, the City Planning and Zoning Department is working towards a comprehensive update of the City's Zoning Regulations, which has not been done since their original adoption in 1982; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this goal, the City has applied for a grant from the Department of Commerce through its Rural Economic Development and Planning Assistance program to fund an outside consultant who will assist City personnel in reviewing the current zoning regulations and reconciling them with other City codes and ordinances as well as zoning regulations from other comparable jurisdictions.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Benson, Arizona, that it hereby declares its support for the Planning and Zoning Department's efforts to draft a comprehensive update to the City's Zoning Regulations and further supports the City's application for a grant from the Arizona Department of Commerce Rural Economic Development and Planning Assistance program to assist this project by funding the services of an outside planning consultant.
