

RESOLUTION NO. 2002-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BENSON, ARIZONA,  
ADOPTING A NOTICE OF INTENTION TO INCREASE PRIMARY PROPERTY TAX  
RATES.

WHEREAS, the City of Benson wishes to increase its current Primary Property Tax rate to generate additional revenue for the general operation of the City of Benson; and

WHEREAS, the City of Benson has complied with the Truth in Taxation Notice and hearing provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes Section 42-17107, by properly notifying the City of Benson's property taxpayers of the tax increase by publication of the required Truth in Taxation Hearing Notices in the local newspaper and by properly holding public hearings on the matter on July 15<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> of 2002;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL as follows:

1. This Resolution shall serve as a written notification of intention to the public that the City of Benson intends to increase the Primary Property Tax Rates; and,
2. The Primary Property Tax Rate for the City of Benson for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2002 and ending June 30, 2003, shall be \$.5955 cents per \$100 dollars of assessed value of taxpayers' real property.
