

RESOLUTION 34-2010

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENSON, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO APPLY FOR A GOVERNOR'S BORDER SECURITY ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM GRANT NOT TO EXCEED \$125,000 TO FUND THE PURCHASE OF POLICE VEHICLES AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, the Governor's Office has announced the Border Security Enhancement Program that provides \$10 million of the State Fiscal Stabilization Funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act in grants to local communities to increase the capacity of county, local and tribal law enforcement agencies to combat criminal activity associated with or directly stemming from the southern border; and

WHEREAS, this grant program requires no matching funds; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police requests authorization to apply for a no-match Governor's Border Security Enhancement Program Grant to fund the purchase of vehicles and associated equipment not to exceed \$125,000.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Benson, Arizona that the Chief of Police is hereby authorized to apply for a Governor's Border Security Enhancement Program grant for the purchase of vehicles and associated equipment not to exceed \$125,000 and to accept said grant if awarded, complying with all required grant terms and conditions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the City is awarded a grant under this program, the Chief of Police is hereby authorized to make such purchases consistent with the terms of the grant and the City's procurement code.
