

RESOLUTION 36-2010

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENSON, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE FIRE CHIEF TO APPLY FOR A DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, FEMA'S ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT TO FUND AN EXHAUST REMOVAL SYSTEM FOR THE CITY'S FIRE STATION

WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security through the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) administers a grant program known as Assistance to Firefighters to fund local first responders to enhance their capabilities; and


WHEREAS, this program requires a five percent local match; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief requests authorization to apply for a grant in the amount of \$56,310 to fund the purchase of an exhaust removal system for the City's Fire Station that would require a City's match of \$2,816.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Benson, Arizona that the Fire Chief is hereby authorized to apply for a grant from the Department of Homeland Security to fund the purchase of exhaust removal equipment in the approximate amount of \$56,310;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the City is awarded the above grant, then the Fire Chief is authorized to expend up to \$2,816 from budgeted FY 2011 Fire Department funds as a local match to purchase said equipment in accordance with the City's procurement code.
