

RESOLUTION 37-2007

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENSON, ARIZONA, APPROVING A WINE FESTIVAL LICENSE FOR CORONADO VINEYARDS, FOR NOVEMBER 13, 2007 AT THE BEST WESTERN MOTEL, 699 N. OCOTILLO, BENSON, ARIZONA.

WHEREAS, Coronado Vineyards, a domestic farm winery, D.F.W. License No.13023009, has applied to the City of Benson for a wine festival license, to allow on-site wine sampling around its booth at the Best Western Motel, on November 13, 2007; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. § 4-203.03(A), the Council may grant up to 25 wine festival licenses per year, for events held within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Benson have reviewed Coronado Vineyard's application, and have determined that its approval is in the best interests of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Benson, Arizona, as follows:

- Section 1.** The Application for Wine Festival License/Wine Fair License submitted by Coronado Vineyards is hereby approved, and the Mayor is authorized to execute the same on behalf of the City.
- Section 2.** All orders or resolutions in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed, and this resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption.
