

RESOLUTION NO. 11-2001

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BENSON, ARIZONA, PROTESTING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A TRAFFIC INTERCHANGE AT B-10 (4TH STREET) AND HIGHWAY 80 PROVIDING DIRECT TRAFFIC ACCESS FROM HIGHWAY 80 TO EXIT 306 ON INTERSTATE 10 AS PROPOSED BY THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.


WHEREAS, the City of Benson believes that the commercial downtown area is an area which is culturally significant to the City of Benson; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council support the tourist traffic activity which promotes economic prosperity to the commercial downtown area; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council understand the growing concern among the merchants of the commercial downtown area that the construction of the proposed interchange will create a bypass away from the downtown Benson area.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL that this Resolution shall serve as written evidence to the Arizona Department of Transportation of the City of Benson's objection and protest to the construction of the proposed traffic interchange at B-10 (4th Street) and Highway 80 providing direct traffic access from Highway 80 to Exit 306 on Interstate 10.


