\*\* Call to the Public

Arizona Revised Statutes §38-431.01(H) provides that "A public body may make an open call to the public during a public meeting, subject to reasonable time, place and manner restrictions to allow individuals to address the public body on any issue within the jurisdiction of the public body. At the conclusion of an open call to the public, individual members of the public body may respond to criticism made by those who have addressed the public body, may ask staff to review a matter or may ask that a matter be put on a future agenda. However, members of the public body shall not discuss or take legal action on matters raised during an open call to the public unless the matters are properly noticed for discussion and legal action." As such, Call to the Public agenda items are provided as a courtesy to allow citizens an opportunity to voice any concerns or opinions they may have regarding the City of Benson or other matters properly addressed to the City Council. However, in accordance with Arizona law, citizens need to understand that the City Council is not permitted to enter into a direct discussion with the citizens speaking on any issues of concern during the Call to the Public and no legal action can be taken, unless the matter is properly noticed on the agenda.

\*\*\* Consent Agenda

The Consent Agenda will be the first item under New Business and shall list separately distinct items requiring action by the City Council that are generally routine items not requiring Council discussion. A single motion will approve all items on the Consent Agenda, including any resolutions or ordinances, or claims/invoices that are of a routine nature. A Councilmember may remove any issue from the Consent Agenda, and that issue will be discussed and voted upon separately, immediately following the Consent Agenda under its proper regular category of New Business.
