*To qualify for discount fare, seniors and persons with disabilities must complete a registration form. Registration forms are available from your driver, can be picked up at City Hall or downloaded online at www.cityofbenson.com.

BAT Vehicles

All BAT vehicles are wheelchair accessible and can transport two wheelchairs or electric scooters. Seats at the front of the bus are reserved for seniors and persons with mobility limitations.



BAT buses are equipped with bike racks which hold up to two bikes and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Folding strollers can be brought on board and must be kept out of the aisle. Gasoline powered bicycles or scooters are not allowed on vehicles or bike racks.



Tips for Riding

- Pay your fare or show a pass when you board the bus. Exact change only, please.
- Eating and consuming alcoholic beverages are not allowed on the bus. Food and drink must be in closed containers.
- Except for service animals, pets must be enclosed in small cages or cardboard boxes.
- No behavior that is unsafe or offensive to other riders will be tolerated on the bus.

Dial-a-Ride Service for Seniors and Persons with Disabilities

BAT also provides curb-to-curb Dial-a-Ride service for eligible seniors (60+) and persons with disabilities. Dial-a-Ride serves Benson, Pomerene, J-Six/Mescal and St. David areas.

Dial-a-Ride operates Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM. Reservations must be made no later than the prior business day by calling 586-9406.

Single Ride – Eligible Disabled** \$2.00

Monthly Pass (unlimited Rides)

Monthly pass - Seniors 60+ \$15.00
(Recommended donation)

Monthly pass – Eligible Disabled** \$15.00

Dial-a-Ride Monthly Pass can be purchase at City Hall or from your driver.

** Must have a documented disability that prevents use of the regular bus stops. Rider must obtain proof of eligibility from their Health Care Professional. Applications are available from your driver, can be picked up at City Hall or downloaded online at www.cityofbenson.com.
