

RESOLUTION 54-2011

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENSON, ARIZONA AUTHORIZING THE FIRE CHIEF TO APPLY FOR A DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, FEMA'S ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTER'S GRANT TO FUND THE PURCHASE OF A NEW ENGINE COMPANY

WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security through the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) administers a grant program known as Assistance to Firefighters to fund local first responders to enhance their capabilities; and


WHEREAS, this program requires a five percent local match; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief requests authorization to apply for a grant in the amount not to exceed \$450,000 to fund the purchase of a new engine company.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Benson, Arizona that the Fire Chief is hereby authorized to apply for a grant from the Department of Homeland Security to fund the purchase of a new engine company in the approximate amount not to exceed \$450,000;

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that if the City receives the grant, then the Fire Chief is authorized to expend up to \$22,500 from budgeted FY 2011-2012 Fire Department funds as a local match to purchase said equipment in accordance with the City's procurement code.


