

RESOLUTION 69-2011

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENSON, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SECTION 5311 FUNDS TO OPERATE A RURAL PUBLIC TRANSIT SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation provides funding to rural communities with a population of less than 50,000 through its Section 5311 programs to fund rural public transit systems that provide rides for elderly and disabled persons on an as-requested basis as well as Deviated Fixed Routes open to the general public on a fare basis; and

WHEREAS, the local elderly/disabled transportation and deviated fixed route programs are currently operated by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City plans to operate the local elderly/ disabled transportation and deviated fixed route programs, provided that funding sources are available.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Benson, Arizona, that the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to apply to the Arizona Department of Transportation for Section 5311 funding to operate a local public transit system as of October 1, 2012, and is further directed to prepare funding and budget proposals and projections for inclusion in the City's FY 2013 budget that set forth the means for acquiring the assets and personnel needed to operate a local transportation service, both a Dial-a-Ride service for the benefit of the region's elderly and disabled persons and for a Deviated Fixed Route System for the fare-paying general public.
