

RESOLUTION 42-2009

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENSON, ARIZONA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION 56-2008 THAT ADOPTED THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION/CITY OF BENSON STATE ROUTE 90 CONCEPTUAL RIGHT-OF-WAY AND ROADWAY PLAN FOR THE CITY OF BENSON DATED NOVEMBER, 2007

WHEREAS, on September 8, 2008 the City of Benson adopted via Resolution 56-2008 a Conceptual Right-of-Way and Roadway Plan for SR-90 applicable within City limits; and

WHEREAS, since that time the Arizona Department of Transportation has adopted a new statewide access management policy; and

WHEREAS, the statewide access management policy with its soon-to-be-issued Access Management Manual better define the expectations of the Arizona Department of Transportation and the City of Benson for Developments desiring to tie into a State highway.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Benson, Arizona that City of Benson Resolution 56-2008 is hereby rescinded and staff is directed to apply the statewide Access Management Manual of the Arizona Department of Transportation for developments within the City that desire to tie into a state highway.
