

RESOLUTION 35-2009

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENSON, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION BY THE BENSON POLICE DEPARTMENT TO THE ARIZONA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF HIGHWAY SAFETY ("GOHS") FOR HIGHWAY SAFETY ACT GRANT FUNDS

WHEREAS, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration ("NHTSA") and the GOHS administers a Highway Safety Program (the "Grant Program") whereby NHTSA allocates federal funds under the Highway Safety Act to fund state and local highway safety projects in areas including, but not limited to, speed enforcement, aggressive driving enforcement and roadway safety; and

WHEREAS, the staff of the Benson Police Department has completed a grant application (the "Application") for the Grant Program, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference, that would enable the City to apply for grant funds through the GOHS for a portion of the funding under the Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Benson have reviewed the terms and conditions of the Application and have determined that submitting the Application is in the best interests of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Benson, that the City hereby approves the Application, attached hereto as Exhibit "A," and authorizes Acting Chief of Police Paul Moncada to execute it, and City staff is hereby authorized to take all steps necessary and proper to carry out its purposes.
