
BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of Benson, Arizona as follows:

RESOLUTION NO. 23-2001

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BENSON,  
ARIZONA, APPROVING THE AMENDMENT TO THE CITY OF BENSON'S 208  
WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN TO ENCOMPASS THE WHETSTONE  
RANCH DEVELOPMENT.**

WHEREAS, the Whetstone Ranch is a planned 15,000 acre development located within the southern portion of the limits of the City of Benson and the City of Benson's previously approved 208 Water Quality Management Plan must be amended to address the issues relating to the wastewater collection and treatment for the planned Whetstone Ranch development; and,


WHEREAS, said proposed amendment to the City of Benson's 208 Water Quality Management Plan has been approved by the City of Benson's Engineers and Southeastern Arizona Governments Organization in its capacity as clearinghouse for water quality management plans and said proposed amendment to the City of Benson's 208 Water Quality Management Plan has been available to the public for inspection for more than the statutorily required time period of forty five (45) days; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on the 8<sup>th</sup> of November, 2001, and after public comment, the proposed amendment was publicly approved after that portion of the Whetstone Ranch development known as Whetstone Springs was removed from the plan at the request of the Arizona State Parks Department on behalf of Kartchner Caverns State Park; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment to the City of Benson's 208 Water Quality Management Plan shall now be forwarded to the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality for final approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BENSON, ARIZONA, that this Resolution shall serve as written evidence of the City of Benson's approval and support of the proposed amendment to the City of Benson's 208 Water Quality Management Plan as submitted by Westland Resources, Incorporated on behalf of the Whetstone Ranch Development.


