

RESOLUTION NO. 2002-30

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BENSON, ARIZONA, DIRECTING STAFF TO APPLY TO THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION FOR A GRANT FOR \$1,100,000 TO CONSTRUCT THE PARALLEL TAXIWAY AND CONNECTING TAXILANES FOR THE BENSON MUNICIPAL AIRPORT.

WHEREAS, the City of Benson desires to expand our Municipal airport and to make it safer for the flying public; and,

WHEREAS, the increased air traffic at this airport mandates that a parallel taxiway and connecting taxilanes be constructed so as to prevent aircraft from using the main runway for taxiing purposes; and


WHEREAS, the City of Benson has already accepted an FAA grant and the design of the parallel taxiway and connecting taxi lanes is already under contract; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Benson agrees to make the required 4.47% cash match for this grant; and,


WHEREAS, this grant request represents 91.06% of the total expected cost of this construction project.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BENSON, ARIZONA, that the City of Benson shall make formal application to the Federal Aviation Administration for a \$1,100,000 A.I.P. grant for the construction of a parallel taxiway and connecting taxilanes for the Benson Municipal Airport.


