

**RESOLUTION NO. 57-2008**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENSON, ARIZONA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 52-2008 AND LIFTING THE TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON THE INVOLUNTARY TERMINATION OF CITY EMPLOYEES.

WHEREAS, on July 30, 2008, the Mayor and Council adopted Resolution No. 52-2008 which imposed a temporary moratorium on involuntary terminations of City employees, pending the hiring of a new permanent City Manager; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 52-2008 provides that the Mayor and Council may lift or suspend the temporary moratorium at any time they find that it is in the best interests of the City to do so; and


WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have reviewed the impact and effect of the temporary moratorium imposed by Resolution No. 52-2008 and find that lifting the moratorium and rescinding Resolution No. 52-2008 is in the best interests of the City, its employees and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Benson that the City hereby lifts the temporary moratorium on involuntary terminations of City employees imposed by Resolution No. 52-2008.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 52-2008 is hereby rescinded and the Mayor and Council of the City of Benson declare Resolution No. 52-2008 null and void.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City's officers and staff are hereby authorized to take all steps necessary and proper to lift the temporary moratorium and rescind Resolution No. 52-2008.


