

RESOLUTION 41-2009

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENSON, ARIZONA APPROVING A TENTATIVE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010

WHEREAS, A.R.S. § 42-17101 requires that the City adopt a tentative budget for the fiscal year by the third Monday in July; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have engaged in numerous public work sessions discussing the proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2009-2010; and

WHEREAS, the City estimates its total revenues and expenditures for FY 2009-2010 to be \$17,949,017 and the City Finance Director has prepared a tentative budget for said amount, which is within the spending limitation set forth in Article IX, Section 20, Arizona State Constitution.




