

RESOLUTION NO. 52-2008

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENSON, ARIZONA, IMPOSING A TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON INVOLUNTARY TERMINATION OF CITY EMPLOYEES.

WHEREAS, on July 28, 2008, the Mayor and Council terminated the City Manager; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have appointed an interim City Manager; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council are conducting a search for a new permanent City Manager; and

WHEREAS, the City of Benson has many highly valued employees, and the City wishes to maintain the confidence and peace of mind of its employees during the search for a new permanent City Manager; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council find that imposing a temporary moratorium on involuntary terminations of City employees, pending the hiring of a new permanent City Manager, is in the best interests of the City, its employees and residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Benson that the City hereby imposes a temporary moratorium on involuntary terminations of City employees, pending the hiring of a new permanent City Manager.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council may lift or suspend this moratorium at any time they find that it is in the best interests of the City to do so.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that nothing contained herein shall create any amnesty nor relieve any City employees of full responsibility for their actions and conduct during this moratorium.
