LOCAL RETIREMENT BOARD MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON
05-16-18**

1. Call to order: 11:15 AM by Member Butler
2. Roll Call: Butler, Knoblock, Douglas and Ingram present
3. Old Business:
 - a. Secretary Graf presented the Minutes of Feb 19, 2016 for members review. Motion to approve by Douglas, 2nd by Ingram, no discussion, All approved "Aye".
4. New Business:
 - a. Local Board welcome aboard New Appointed Member Joe Knoblock to the Benson Fire / Police Local PSPRS Board.

Sec. Graf said Joe was approved by the City via consent agenda during the April 9, 2018 Council Meeting. Joe spoke of his prior experience of being a PSPRS Secretary with CCSO, he retired from the system. It was noted Joe had also served several terms as the JP3 Magistrate. Motion to approve by Ingram, Douglas 2nd, no discussion, All approved "Aye".

- b. Local Board review and approval of Troy McGoffin return to work, "Different position", with the City of Benson.

Sec. Graf said he was informed by the new HR coordinator for the need of item a. and b. prior to the PSPRS could determine if an alternate contribution Subsidy is applicable. He said Troy McGoffin retired after a noteworthy 27.5 years of public service on 5/17/15 from the Benson Police Department as a Corporal. On 09/17/15 he applied, interviewed and was hired to work at the Cities Golf Course as a Customer Service rep. On 06/27/16 he applied (internal), interviewed and received the position of Parks Maintenance 1. McGoffin then applied (internal) and was hired as a Utilities Worker 1 on 3/26/18 to present.

Member Butler recommended "Approved" be replaced with "The board acknowledges and is aware retired member Troy McGoffin returned to

work with the City of Benson, different position". Douglas motioned by repeating Butler's statement, Ingram 2nd. No further discussion. All approved "Aye".

- c. Local Board review and approval of Paul Moncada return to work, "Same position" with the City of Benson.


Sec. Graf noted retired member Paul Moncada retired as a Commander from the Benson Police Department on 01-31-2008. The position of Administrative Corporal was vacant and posted, he applied and was hired on 02-01-08. Sec. Graf read the e-mail he sent to Joann Lowery the Retired Members Team Leader with PSPRS: "I received an e-mail from our HR reference return to work local board approval on a member who returned to work after retirement in 2008. My question is: The board did not convene, review or approve the eligibility, is there a statute of limitation on board action? Also, if there is a violation, what are the sanctions-penalties etc., if a member did return to work in a similar capacity with the same employer".

Sec. Graf then read Joann Lowey's e-mail response "No, to all-in this case. It is just to acknowledge that the retired member returned to work in 2008 and alternate contributions were not applicable. After conferring with our Director, we are not looking into details regarding the retiree returning to work prior to September 2013 which is when the Subsidy became available to retirees returning to active work for an employer of the plan. Sec. Graf noted Alternate Contribution Rates (ACR) did not go into effect until July 1, 2011.

Sec. Graf added that based on Joann Lowey's e-mail the purpose of this item is for the board to acknowledge that Paul Moncada returned to work Feb 1st, 2008 and alternate contribution rates (ACR) did not apply at that time.

Douglas motioned that the board acknowledge and is aware retired member Paul Moncada returned to work with the City of Benson prior to alternate contribution rates going into effect. Ingram 2nd, No further discussion. All approved "Aye".

- 6. Adjournment- Motion to adjourn by Douglas, 2nd by Ingram. All approved "Aye".
