MINUTES

CALL TO THE PUBLIC:

1. Michelle Johnson from the City of Benson was present.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. The proposed new residence to be built by David Fortner on a vacant lot in the Historic Neighborhood on West 6th Street in Benson: The Committee requests the building plans be modified to substitute either a wood, or a wood-look railing on the front porch, in lieu of what appears to be an iron railing. Gus Figueroa made a motion to allow the building plans to go forth as is, with the exception that a wood, or wood-look railing on the front porch be substituted. The motion was approved by a vote 6-0. Ruth Wilson will let David Fortner, the builder, know regarding the change requested by the Commission.
2. A proposed fundraising effort during Butterfield Days on October 14 and 15: Discussion was had regarding the photos we wish to have duplicated for sale during Butterfield Days, including,
 - a. the size, color, and cost of printing;
 - b. the proposed selling price;
 - c. special orders for larger photos; and
 - d. the particular photos to be duplicated.

Also discussed were setup materials and times (Joanne Sturgeon is supplying the tent, and Ruth Wilson tables, chairs and display boards), and volunteers and their work schedules.
