

RESOLUTION 1-2014

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENSON, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION(S) FOR FY 2014 STATE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDS, CERTIFYING THAT SAID APPLICATION(S) MEETS THE COMMUNITY'S PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT NEEDS AND THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE CDBG PROGRAM, AND AUTHORIZING ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT AND COMPLETE THE ACTIVITIES OUTLINED IN SAID APPLICATION(S)

WHEREAS, the City of Benson is desirous of undertaking community development activities; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona is administering the Community Development Block Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the State CDBG Program requires that CDBG funds requested address one of the three Congressional mandated National Objectives; and

WHEREAS, the activities within these applications address the community's identified housing and community development needs, including the needs of low- and moderate-income persons; and

WHEREAS, an Applicant of State CDBG funds is required to comply with the program guidelines and Federal Statutes and regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the City of Benson, Arizona, authorize application(s) to be made to the State of Arizona, Department of Housing for FY 2014 CDBG funds, and authorize the Mayor to sign application(s) and contracts or grant documents for receipt and use of these funds to provide ADA bathrooms and sidewalks at Lions Park; and/or for sidewalks in North Benson, to be written and administered by SEAGO for a fee not to exceed 12% of the total allocation and authorize the Mayor to take all actions necessary to implement and complete the activities submitted in said application(s); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the application(s) for State CDBG funds meets the requirements of low-and moderate-income benefit for activities justified as benefiting low- and moderate-income persons, aids in the prevention or elimination of slum and blight or addresses an urgent need which poses a threat to health; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Benson will comply with all State CDBG Program guidelines, Federal Statutes and regulations applicable to the State CDBG Program and the certifications contained in these application(s).


