

RESOLUTION 11-2017

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENSON, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND/OR THE FIRE CHIEF TO APPLY FOR A GRANT FROM THE TOHONO O'ODHAM NATION TO PURCHASE NEW FIRE EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has determined that in 2017 it will provide grant funding to support local governments' expenditures in areas including public safety; and

WHEREAS, the Benson Volunteer Fire Department has determined that it is in need of additional personal protective equipment for its firefighters, including turnout pants and jackets, boots, and helmets; and

WHEREAS, the City plans to purchase new personal protective equipment for its fire fighters if funding sources are available.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Benson, Arizona, that the City Manager and/or Fire Chief is hereby authorized and directed to apply to and, if awarded, accept grant funding through the Tohono O'odham Nation to purchase personal protective equipment used in fire-fighting, including turnout pants and jackets, boots, and helmets, and is further directed to prepare funding and budget proposals and projections for inclusion in the City's future budgets that set forth the means for acquiring the equipment.


