

RESOLUTION 13-2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENSON, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND/OR THE POLICE CHIEF TO APPLY FOR A GRANT FROM THE TOHONO O'ODHAM NATION TO PURCHASE NEW POLICE EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has determined that in 2018 it will provide grant funding to support local governments' expenditures in areas including public safety; and

WHEREAS, the City's Police Chief has determined that the City Police Department is in need of body cameras and attendant media storage; and

WHEREAS, the City plans to purchase body cameras and attendant media storage for City police officers if funding sources are available.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Benson, Arizona, that the City Manager and/or Police Chief is hereby authorized and directed to apply to and, if awarded, accept grant funding through the Tohono O'odham Nation to purchase body cameras and attendant media storage for use by City Police Officers while on duty, and is further directed to prepare funding and budget proposals and projections for inclusion in the City's future budgets that set forth the means for acquiring the equipment.


