

RESOLUTION 2-2012

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENSON, ARIZONA, REPEALING RESOLUTION 18-92 AND DESIGNATING AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO 70% OF THE PROCEEDS FROM THE TRANSIENT LODGING TAX TO FUND THE BUSINESS OPERATIONS OF THE BENSON/SAN PEDRO VALLEY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE

WHEREAS the Benson City Council passed, on June 1, 1989, Ordinance number 321, which imposed a transient lodging tax on certain businesses operating within the city limits of Benson, Arizona; and,

WHEREAS the Benson City Council does not desire to designate where and how these additional tax monies are to be used, but does request that a quarterly report be made to the City Council as to the progress of the Chamber expenditures related to these funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Benson/San Pedro Valley Chamber of Commerce is hereby designated as the recipient of an amount equal to 70% of all of the funds obtained from the two percent (2%) tax levied upon transient lodging by Ordinance #321. The Benson/San Pedro Valley Chamber of Commerce may expend these funds for any legal Chamber of Commerce purpose, including, but not limited to, promoting tourism in the City of Benson and for the purpose of advertising the amenities of the City of Benson.
