

RESOLUTION 24-2012

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENSON, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO APPLY FOR A GRANT FROM THE TOHONO O'ODHAM NATION FOR TRAINING EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, each year, pursuant to the terms of its gaming compact with the State of Arizona, the Tohono O'odham Nation makes a certain percentage of its gaming revenues available as grants to local Arizona governments and community non-profit enterprises; and


WHEREAS, the terms of the subject grants do not require matching funds; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police requests authorization to apply for a grant from the Tohono O'odham Nation in the amount of \$10,000 for training equipment and related expenses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Benson, Arizona, that the Chief of Police is hereby authorized to apply for a grant from the Tohono O'odham Nation in the amount of \$10,000 to fund the purchase of training equipment and related expenses.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the grant proposal is selected for funding by the Tohono O'odham Nation, then the Chief of Police is authorized to expend such funds consistent with the terms of the grant and the City's procurement policies, and to execute all documents necessary to accept and expend the grant funds.


