



WHEREAS, pursuant to Arizona law and the Benson City Code, Chapter 2, Article 2-3, Sections 2-3-3 and 2-3-4, at the Primary Election the candidate receiving a majority of all votes cast for the office of Mayor and the candidates receiving a majority of all votes cast for the office of Councilmember shall be declared to be elected to the offices of Mayor and Councilmember; and

WHEREAS, it appears that Joe Konrad received a number of votes constituting a majority of all the valid votes cast for the office of Mayor and should be deemed elected in accordance with Arizona law; and

WHEREAS, it appears that Patrick Boyle received a number of votes constituting a majority of all the valid votes cast for a 4-year term Councilmember and should be deemed elected in accordance with Arizona law; Toney D. King, Sr. received a number of votes constituting a majority of all the valid votes cast for a 4-year term Councilmember and should be deemed elected in accordance with Arizona law; and Anicleto (Nick) Maldonado received a number of votes constituting a majority of all the valid votes cast for a 4-year term Councilmember and should be deemed elected in accordance with Arizona law; and

WHEREAS, it appears that Larry Dempster received a number of votes constituting a majority of all the valid ballots cast for a 2-year term Councilmember and should be deemed elected in accordance with Arizona law; and

WHEREAS, there is no remaining office of Mayor or Councilmember that was not filled by a number of votes constituting a majority of all the valid votes cast for each office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Benson, Arizona, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the total number of ballots cast at the primary election was 1,379.

SECTION 2. That it is determined and declared of record, Proposition 400 – AEL (Home Rule) did receive a majority of the total number of all votes cast and was thereby approved by the voters of the City and shall govern the City of Benson from fiscal year 2021-2022 through fiscal year 2024-2025.

**RESOLUTION 25-2020**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENSON, ARIZONA, CANVASSING, DECLARING, AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE PRIMARY ELECTION HELD ON AUGUST 4, 2020**

WHEREAS, on the 4th day of August, 2020, a primary election of the qualified electors of the City of Benson, Arizona, was held for the purpose of presenting Proposition 400, considering the question of extending the Alternative Expenditure Limitation (AEL), also known as the Home Rule Option ("Home Rule"); and electing one (1) mayor for a two-year term, three (3) councilmembers to each serve four-year terms, and one (1) councilmember to serve a previously vacated two-year term; and and

WHEREAS, the election returns, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference, have been presented to and have been canvassed by the Mayor and City Council; and

WHEREAS, the election returns as canvassed show that there were 1,379 ballots cast; and

WHEREAS, the election returns as canvassed show the number of votes cast for Proposition 400 and for each candidate is as follows:
