A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENSON, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO APPLY FOR A TOHONO O'ODHAM GRANT TO FUND EQUIPMENT AND OVERTIME

WHEREAS, each year the Tohono O'odham Nation awards grants to Arizona cities, counties and towns for public health and safety purposes from gaming revenue; and


WHEREAS, the City of Benson desires to submit a grant proposal to fund equipment and overtime; and

WHEREAS, this year's deadline is June 30, 2011.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Benson, Arizona, that the Chief of Police is authorized to submit a grant proposal to the Tohono O'odham Nation to fund equipment and overtime;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the City is awarded said grant, the Chief of Police is hereby authorized to purchase equipment from the grant funds in accordance with the City's procurement code and take all steps necessary and proper to carry out its purposes.


